Gypsy Moth Status

The community group led by Mary Anderson (734 dash 216 dash 1567) has been active this fall. They conducted an egg mass search and identified a gypsy moth infested area. The area includes Community Dr, the western part of Winans Dr, and Winans Lake Rd roughly from Keystone to the east side of Chilson.

They are in the process of obtaining cost estimates from aerial sprayers along with information on what paperwork needs to be in place for the spraying to occur. Once the information is available, they will put together an information packet that will be distributed to neighbors.
