WLA Beach Parking

The WLA and LGCC are investigating the possibility of expanding the beach parking area to help address safety issues caused by vehicles parking on the side of Pleasant Lake Rd. Overflow parking on the road poses a serious safety issue to the public, as the road is not wide enough to safely accommodate parking. Over the years, roadside parking has also caused complaints from citizens, Hamburg Township and Livingston County. The preliminary plan is to expand the current area approximately 100 ft south, which should allow space to park an additional 6-8 vehicles. This should be enough to accommodate beach parking needs for all but busiest days which, in turn, should significantly improve public safety and help avoid any governmental issues.
