Through the continuing cooperation and participation of its membership, the WLA has kept Winans Lake clean and free of invasive species like Zebra and Quagga Mussels. The association's maintenance work over many years has also successfully minimized Eurasian Milfoil, an invasive water plant.

The WLA maintains the beach house at the east end of the lake and several boat easements around the lake for the enjoyment of all members. It also sponsors several social events throughout the year for lake residents and their families, including day-long July Fourth activities.

Use of the lake for swimming (including the beach club), boating, and fishing requires activation of your WLA membership. WLA members are a membership class of the Lakelands Golf and Country Club (LGCC) and enjoy some limited club benefits, including dining.
