The *DNR* strongly **discourages dumping leaves and grass clippings** into a lake, river, wetland, or other body of water. Leaves, grass clippings and similar debris add nutrients to the water that use up precious oxygen as they decompose.

You can do your part to help maintain our lake's water quality by not blowing your leaves into the lake.

Association Rules Changes

Changes were made at the November board meeting to two association rules. The revised rules read as follows:

<u>Fishing Rule 13:</u> Battery powered ice drills are allowed. Ice holes must not exceed 8" in diameter. Gas powered ice augers or other gas-powered equipment or chainsaws may not be used to create holes in the ice.

Boats Rule 4: Motor propelled watercraft of any kind, or motorized vehicles of any description, including personal watercraft, automobiles, snowmobiles, ORVs or aircraft may not be used on Winans Lake, except as specifically designated by the Board for lake maintenance. Abutting WLA members may use motor-driven or motor-propelled snow removal equipment, but not plow-equipped motor vehicles, to clear an area for ice skating.
