The *DNR* strongly **discourages dumping leaves and grass clippings** into a lake, river, wetland, or other body of water. Leaves, grass clippings and similar debris add nutrients to the water that use up precious oxygen as they decompose.



You can do your part to help maintain our lake's water quality by not blowing your leaves into the lake.

MSU Extension's popular Introduction to Lakes Online course is back in session January 10!



This six-week online course is designed for anyone interested in inland lakes, including lakefront property owners, recreational users, and managers. Over 1,500 people have participated in the class since it was first offered online in 2015.

In this course, you will learn about inland lake ecology, management, and protection through six interactive online units. Inland lakes are complex ecosystems and are often negatively affected by both the people that live near them as well as the water that drains into them. Frequently, local communities struggle to protect and manage inland lakes in a way that incorporates the best available knowledge and resources.
