Spring Reminders

This year the first half of the saying "in Like a Lion, out Like a Lamb" is certainly holding true. The lake even had a thin film of ice on March 7th. We can only hope that the second half of the saying holds true as well. Tips of early daffodils are showing in the garden so that is promising.

In preparation for spring, here are a couple of reminders for this month:



- If you haven't already, please return your ice fishing flags to Greg Dygert.
- Pike season is closed March 16th through April 29th inclusive.
- Protect our lake's water quality through good spring cleanup practices minimizing nutrient runoff into the lake:
 - Remove ashes from lakeside firepits so they don't leach into the lake.
 - Don't fertilize within 50 feet of the lake and use a zero phosphorous fertilizer (the middle number should be zero, for example: 30/0/10).
- Access Site Audits and Clean-outs
 - The WLA Board will be continuing their work auditing and clearing out access sites. There are still a large number of unregistered boats on the NE (Ferguson's) access site. If you have a boat there, please make sure it has a WLA decal and number or it may be removed.
