Information comes to the attention of the WLA board that is not associated with the association's charter but is still of interest to the community. This section is added to pass on that information to the Winans Lake community.

## **Cowell Road Work in July**

The WLA has learned that the Livingston County Road Commission (LCRC) plans to install a limestone surface on Cowell Rd from Teahen Rd east to Hamburg Rd (limestone was previously installed on Cowell from Teahen West to Chilson in 2021). This work is expected to occur the week after the 4th of July or the following week. Residents may want to seek alternate routes and avoid the area during the construction.

The limestone surface should improve the road quality, minimize maintenance, improve drainage and reduce the amount of sediment flowing into the lake. This project is not being conducted or funded as part of the Winans Lake Drain, but it is clearly a consequence of the WLA's efforts in focusing attention on the road and drainage issues in the area.
