Scarlet lily beetle



The scarlet lily beetle made its first appearance last summer and has returned with a vengeance this summer. The beetle will not only demolish all varieties of lilies (except day lilies) but will also munch on fritillaria. Vigilance and persistence in finding and killing the little bug(gers) is the best way to control them.
