Just a couple of quick notes on our lake's status:

- 1. The initial milfoil treatment took place on June 10th and it has proven to be very effective. While not confirmed, at this time a second treatment is not anticipated.
- 2. Water lily treatment was offered to qualifying lakefront owners and those who personally contracted for the service had their waterlily beds treated Wednesday August 7th.
